Financial "brief" Overview:

Our Orchestra Guild current account balance: \$8,517.23.

We spent \$8,504.89 on equipment and programming this year, benefiting all orchestra students in grades 4 - 12.

We raised \$4,022 through events and fund-raising.

(This does NOT include funds in the Beaver Music Boosters general fund or individual student fund-raising.)

Highlights of the Year:

The Orchestra sent 9 students to PMEA District Orchestra, 6 students to PMEA Western Region Orchestra, and 3 string students to PMEA All-state Orchestra. The Beaver Area School District has had students qualify for All-State Orchestra for 11 years in a row.

The HS Orchestra earned a I, or superior rating in the PMEA Music Performance Adjudication in April, and the MS Orchestra earned a II.

The Orchestra Guild provided resources and support for elementary dress rehearsals, the Caryn Lin workshop (in October) and the concert with Caryn in March, the

December concert at Park Presbyterian Church and coordinated 2 fund-raisers open to all BASD music students in grades 7-12 – the Anderson's Chocolate Bar sales, and the Bobcat Travel Mug sales. Guild parents also provided hospitality and support for the MPA event hosted by Mrs. Graham and Mr. Scanga.

We are extremely grateful to many parents who donated supplies, cookies, and snacks. Special recognition goes to our parents who helped with the many tasks of hosting and putting on our big March concert, as well as on-going duties with financial accounting, and fund-raising opportunities. Simply put, without these generous and skilled individuals who give time and talent, our students would not have the support and joy they experience in our music program.
